**DEBUT IN WASHINGTON, DC FOLLOWS SELL-OUT RUNS
IN EDINBURGH AND LONDON'S WEST END**

(Washington, DC) **The Pajama Men**, known to their mothers as Mark Chavez and Shenoah Allen, present *In the Middle of No One*, a delightfully silly thriller about love, alien abduction, and the spirit of adventure, at **Woolly Mammoth Theatre Company**, December 11, 2012 - January 6, 2013.

Originally from Albuquerque, New Mexico, **The Pajama Men** have become stars of the international comedy circuit. They smashed all previous box office records at London's Soho Theatre in 2010, earned the title "Double Act of the Year" by *The London Times*, and have produced the highest rated show at the Edinburgh Fringe, the world's largest arts festival. This holiday season, **The Pajama Men** bring their trademark style of blink-of-an-eye character switches and plot twists to DC.

"Accompanied onstage by guitarist Kevin Hume, *In the Middle of No One* is a sort-of mash-up of long-form improvisation, mime, slapstick, clown, and physical theatre," says Woolly Managing Director Jeffrey Herrmann. "**The Pajama Men** have caused quite a stir in the UK and Australia and have even worked with our friends, The Second City, in Chicago. We're thrilled to be welcoming Mark and Shenoah and their pajama wardrobe to Washington, DC for the holidays, and we hope this will be the beginning of a long relationship."

ABOUT THE PAJAMA MEN

Mark Chavez and Shenoah Allen, the pajama-wearing comedy duo from Albuquerque, New Mexico, have been making waves in the international comedy circuit for the past several years. Along the way, they've attained the Barry Award at the 2009 Melbourne International Comedy Festival, the Best Newcomer and Best of the Fest at the 2009 Sydney Comedy Festival, and sold out a season at the Sydney Opera House.

The Pajama Men performed their first show in 2000 under the name Sabotage, and began touring Canadian fringe festivals. After appearing at the Edinburgh Fringe in 2004 and again in 2005, they renamed themselves **The Pajama Men** and relocated to Chicago where they were the first and only independent act represented by The Second City. Upon returning to Edinburgh

in 2008, they garnered numerous accolades and have played in comedy venues in the United Kingdom and Australia, including London's Soho Theatre, as well as a sold out season at the Sydney Opera House.

The design and production values of their shows are purposefully simple. In performance, the duo wears only their eponymous button-up pajamas. "We shift between characters and situations very quickly," Allen and Chavez explain. "We didn't want to get bogged down with sets and costumes or even much lighting. We keep it simple so we can improvise and change things up. It's more about what's taking place inside your head while you're watching the show and less about what we're wearing."

The Pajama Men: *In the Middle of No One* runs December 11, 2012 – January 6, 2013; Wednesdays and Thursdays at 8pm, Fridays and Saturdays at 7pm and 9pm (Friday, December 14 only at 8pm); and Sundays at 2pm and 7pm. Tuesday, December 11 will be a Pay-What-You-Can performance beginning at 8pm.
